

The Book of Micah

Micah was a prophet who preached between 742 and 687 B.C. before the capture by the Babylonians. He warned the people and kings to stop being so wicked. He told them to turn to God. Only love for God will move people to do what is right, and save them from God's judgement. (Of course, they didn't listen as we know). He also promised a new, great leader would come from Bethlehem (700 years before Jesus was born!) who would shepherd God's flock with strength and majesty. "He will be their peace."
